Abstract Submission Guidelines

- Abstracts should be no longer than 300 words in length and give a general summary of the proposed topic including brief notes on how it is relevant to the symposium theme of “Conservation Through Aviculture”.
- Abstracts are preferred to be received via email and should be sent as a Microsoft Word document, preferably in rich text format (.rtf), however a word document (.doc) is also acceptable. Please send abstracts to info@isbbc.org.
- Abstracts should not include diagrams or references.
- Papers and presentations should attempt to appeal to a wide array of delegates, including the aviculturist, zoologist, ornithologist and conservationist.
- If accepted, authors are expected to have their full manuscript and a final copy of the abstract submitted no later than May 31st, 2007 unless otherwise discussed with the symposium coordinators.
- Manuscripts will be printed in the symposium proceedings for September 2007, the author will be provided with a complimentary copy.
- If accepted, presenters will be offered a 40% discount off of their registration fee.
